Reference to para 2 of your application wherein you have referred NABL letter NABL/RTI/111/2012 dated 26 October 2012, we would like to inform you that we have sought clarification from MCI on the subject vide letter dated 12.08.2014. MCI has clarified vide their letter No.MCI 211(2)(Gen)/2014 Ethics/1186/2 dated 11.06.2017 wherein it was informed that All lab reports to be signed / countersigned by persons registered with MCI / State Medical Council. Further the stakeholders filed a write petition in Honorable Delhi High Court vide W.P. (C) 6740/2017 and CM No. 28057/2017 and the court ordered on 15.09.2017 differentiating technical report and medical laboratory report.
