Mr. R. D. Rastogi, learned Additional Solicitor General submits that the Government of India has received several representations/objections to the draft notification proposing to prescribe minimum qualification for the basic laboratories. He submits that all such representations/objections are being considered pursuant to order of this Court and subsequent order passed by the Delhi High Court. He submits that minimum period of six months may be granted to the Government of India to consider all such objections and publish the final notification.

Mr. A. K. Bhandari, learned Amicus Curiae submits that the draft notification in the present case was published on 18.05.2018 and subsequently revised draft notification was issued

on 15.03.2019. Thus, already more than six months have lapsed even from the date of issuance of revised draft notification. Large number of reports are being authenticated by the persons, who are not at all qualified to do so and the people are being exploited. He therefore submits that the Government of India should be required to expedite the process of finalization and publication of the notification.

Having regard to the submissions aforementioned, we grant three months time to the Government of India to finalize and publish the notification.

Mr. Sandeep Pathak, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the Rajasthan Association of Allied Health Professionals Technologist submits that he has filed an application with the prayer that the State Government may be directed to consider the applications of the Members of the Association for registration under the Rules of 2013.

Dr. Vibhuti Bhushan Sharma, learned Additional Advocate General appearing on behalf of the respondent-State prays for time to seek instructions and file reply to the aforesaid application.

He may do so before the next date of hearing.

List this matter on 17.11.2019, as prayed.
